FINANCIAL AID POLICY & GUIDELINES

Legacy Academy is committed to offering quality classical Christian education to a wide range of families who align with our mission, vision and philosophy. Therefore, Legacy partners with individuals, businesses and philanthropic organizations to assist families in affording private education. We are grateful for these generous supporters in providing financial aid for Legacy families.

Financial aid is awarded annually to families who apply and is based on family need, number of requests received and amount of financial aid available in a given year. Families seeking financial aid must re-apply annually and understand that award amounts may vary from year-to-year. While Legacy desires to assist individual families financially, we have an obligation to all our partners to steward the school's resources with fiscal responsibility.

Legacy partners with a third-party organization, FACTS, to determine a family's financial need. FACTS applies standardized criteria to make a recommendation to the school as to the amount of tuition a family can afford to pay, and therefore, the amount of aid they should receive. The Legacy Board of Directors reviews all FACTS recommendations and makes the final determination of the amount of financial aid the school can offer.

To be considered for financial aid, families must be enrolled at Legacy Academy. The school will not consider financial aid applications until a family has completed the admissions process for the upcoming school year. Prospective families are welcome to submit a financial aid application along with their admissions application to expedite the review process. Returning families are encouraged to re-apply for financial aid upon completion of re-enrollment.

Legacy has allocated 70% of its available financial aid funds to returning (re-enrolled) families and 30% to new (first-time enrolled) families. Legacy also encourages new families to consider the Cornerstone Educational Scholarship, administered by ACE Scholarships, as additional means of obtaining financial aid.
